British Sporting Relations with Apartheid South Africa Matthew P. Llewellyn, Toby C. Rider, 2024-11-25 The transnational anti-apartheid sport boycott of South Africa represented the most prominent, extended, and controversial antiracism campaign in the history of sport.
