**Dosso's Fate** Dosso Dossi, 1998 Dosso Dossi has long been considered one of Renaissance Italy's most intriguing artists. Although a wealth of documents chronicles his life, he remains, in many ways, an enigma, and his art continues to be as elusive as it is compelling. In Dosso's Fate, leading scholars from a wide range of disciplines examine the social, intellectual, and historical contexts of his art, focusing on the development of new genres of painting, questions of style and chronology, the influence of courtly culture, and the work of his collaborators, as well as his visual and literary sources and his painting technique. The result is an important and original contribution not only to literature on Dosso Dossi but also to the study of cultural history in early modern Italy.

[Spaces, Objects and Identities in Early Modern Italian Medicine](#) Sandra Cavallo, David Gentilcore, 2009-03-25 This collection, by an international team of scholars, presents exciting research currently being undertaken on early modern Italy which questions the conventional boundaries of medical history. Brings together historians of medicine and scholars of different backgrounds who are re-visiting the field from new perspectives and with the support of innovative questions and unexplored sources. Explores crucial areas of intersection between the territory of medicine and that of law, politics, religion, art and material culture and highlights the connections between these apparently separate fields. Challenges our understanding of what we regard as medical activities, medical identities, spaces and objects. Addresses the study of medical careers, medical identities and spaces where medical activities were performed e.g. apothecary shops, courtrooms, convents and museums.

**The Creation, Diffusion, and Reception of Italian Art in the Early Modern Iberian World** Corinna Tania Gallori, Benito Navarrete Prieto, 2025-05-30 This edited volume addresses the circulation of works of art, images, and ideas between the Iberian and Italian world and the subsequent responses this motion generated. Amongst the themes discussed are the concepts of centre and periphery, replicas and alterations, and how items and ideas were reinterpreted. The processes of appropriation and transformation create an artistic geography of identities in which originality can be studied through the processes of assimilation of images shared between Europe, Asia, and America. Chapters challenge the negative conceptualization of "copying" arguing that the "copy" is not simply a derivation but a new creation that is shaped by the interests and preferences of the receiver. Similarly, contributors argue for a more nuanced concept of what exactly an

artistic centre is. The book will be of interest to scholars working in art history, Renaissance studies, and Iberian studies.

*Urban Heritage Management* Anna Maria Colavitti, 2018-01-02 This book explores the in-depth relationship between historic-cultural heritage and landscape, urban, and regional planning. It analyzes recent cultural and discipline positions and addresses research to interpret legacy values and the necessity for conservation within the urban setting. It also presents a method that helps urban planners to implement the suggestions, based on extensive knowledge of topographic methods and urban archaeology, to enhance the shaping and planning of the historic and present-day city. A rapid evolution of techniques and methods that provide innovative planning instruments and contribute to conservation projects involving cities and territories is now being witnessed in urban planning. Actors involved in the planning process use an organic and multidisciplinary vision of techniques and methods to understand the relation between the historic-cultural goods and their settlement context. Through urban archaeology it is now possible to orient—in a systematic way—interventions in the historic centers of European cities and document the origin and evolution of the urban shape, to reconcile renewal demand and preservation of ancient heritage.

Multisensory Living in Ancient Rome Hannah Platts, 2019-11-28 Classicists have long wondered what everyday life was like in ancient Greece and Rome. How, for example, did the slaves, visitors, inhabitants or owners experience the same home differently? And how did owners manipulate the spaces of their homes to demonstrate control or social hierarchy? To answer these questions, Hannah Platts draws on a diverse range of evidence and an innovative amalgamation of methodological approaches to explore multisensory experience – auditory, olfactory, tactile, gustatory and visual – in domestic environments in Rome, Pompeii and Herculaneum for the first time, from the first century BCE to the second century CE. Moving between social registers and locations, from non-elite urban dwellings to lavish country villas, each chapter takes the reader through a different type of room and offers insights into the reasons, emotions and cultural factors behind perception, recording and control of bodily senses in the home, as well as their sociological implications. Multisensory Living in Ancient Rome will appeal to all students and researchers interested in Roman daily life and domestic architecture.

The Etruscans Outside Etruria Paolo Bernardini, 2004 During the last millennium B.C., before the coming of the Romans, the Etruscans built a thriving civilization in the western Mediterranean basin, which was rich in natural resources. From the

eighth century B.C., Etruria became a destination on the Italian peninsula for refined works by artisans of the Hellenic regions, the Near East, and central Europe, and for masters from these regions, who emigrated and began to work for the local clientele. These artisans would contribute significantly to the development of an art that was recognizably Etruscan. The influence of Etruscan civilization on other cultures has received less attention from archaeologists than has the effect of the Eastern and Greek worlds on Etruscan culture. This lavishly illustrated volume seeks to redress this imbalance by tracing the Etruscans' impact beyond Etruria. It focuses on the panorama of their commerce and the Etruscan ideological and cultural initiatives that radiated from their native territory into other regions. Etruscan civilization spread across a surprisingly vast area, from ancient Italy out into the Mediterranean basin and continental Europe. The book devotes new attention to details that vary from region to region, with a number of chapters devoted to regional specialists. They offer fresh perspectives on the history, art, and political organization of a culture that, in many ways, remains mysterious.

**Corrado Cagli** Raffaele Bedarida,2018-03-15T00:00:00+01:00 Quando Corrado Cagli, pittore affermato e figura di spicco della Scuola di Roma, sceglie l'esilio, ha solo 28 anni, ma ha già alle spalle una carriera brillante: ha esposto tra l'altro alla Triennale di Milano e alla Biennale di Venezia. Nel 1938 la dittatura irrigidisce il suo volto e Cagli, ebreo e aperto al dialogo con le avanguardie internazionali, diventa un bersaglio per il regime, deciso a importare in Italia la campagna nazista contro l'arte degenerata. Cagli espatria quindi negli Stati Uniti, dove resterà fino al 1947. Saranno, questi, anni cruciali per lui, dal punto di vista personale e artistico: allo scoppio della guerra si arruola nell'esercito americano e torna in Europa a combattere, documentando l'esperienza con una serie drammatica di disegni; approfondisce la tecnica dei murali, confrontandosi con la scuola messicana allora in auge negli Stati Uniti; acquistati dal MoMA, i disegni di guerra gli procurano la prestigiosa Guggenheim Fellowship; lavora quindi per la neonata Ballet Society di Balanchine. Vicino alla rivista «View» e al suo ambiente surrealista, Cagli inoltre porta avanti una ricerca spaziale che lo condurrà ai disegni astratti sulla «quarta dimensione». Un decennio nomade, quello di Cagli, e finora poco conosciuto, ricostruito in questo studio grazie a un approfondito lavoro di scavo in un ricco materiale inedito, iconografico e testuale, in gran parte pubblicato qui per la prima volta. Un esilio come un cammino di trasformazione, che gli consente di sviluppare appieno la sua poetica: l'arte come ricerca, che matura attraverso percorsi paralleli e una molteplicità di linguaggi e contenuti; un'arte multidirezionale, apparentemente schizofrenica, di respiro internazionale. Come osserva Enrico Crispolti nella Prefazione, sarà proprio questa complessità, questa novità straordinaria - difficile da comprendere nel clima settario e fazioso del dopoguerra italiano - la ragione profonda, malcelata sotto critiche di carattere ideologico e politico, dell'ostracismo subito da Cagli una volta tornato in Italia, un ostracismo che su di lui peserà quasi come un nuovo esilio, questa volta in patria.

Questo volume, presentando un panorama di brevi saggi che si riferiscono a ricerche, per lo più in corso, di ampio respiro o che portano contributi scientifici su tematiche attualmente in discussione, vuole rendere omaggio, in occasione del suo settantesimo compleanno, ad Andrea Vanni Desideri, uno studioso che dispone di un profilo scientifico tanto peculiare quanto originale nel panorama della ricerca archeologica fra età medievale e prima Età Moderna, nella conservazione dei beni culturali, in attività accademiche e di diffusione mirata dei 'prodotti' della ricerca nella società civile. Il volume comprende saggi di metodologia della ricerca (dalle tecnologie diagnostiche sperimentali, alle nuove frontiere dell'archeomatica), indagini interdisciplinari o 'leggere' in contesti 'fragili' del Vicino Oriente (dall'insediamento alla conservazione dell'Heritage, alla 'terza missione' universitaria). Le tematiche affrontate comprendono studi sul popolamento urbano e rurale, sotto diversi profili e relativi ad aree non solo toscane (dall'archeologia militante all'utilizzo della sua componente preistorica in un'ottica diacronica, prima e dopo il Medioevo), alla ceramologia archeologica (anch'essa ad ampio spettro cronologico), alla museografia come comunicazione ed organizzazione di cultura archeologica in senso lato. Uno strumento bibliografico, questo, che, pur muovendo dai settori coltivati da Andrea Vanni Desideri, offre motivo di aggiornamento e di

indirizzo scientifico su temi peculiari, nei limiti di comunicazioni brevi ma che contengono precisi rinvii anche bibliografici per raggiungere in letteratura una serie di progetti spesso di ampio respiro, storico e archeologico.
