Cuando se emplean iniciales, ello obedece únicamente a razones de índole personal. Y cuando falta algún nombre, se debe a un fallo de la memoria humana, aunque todo ocurrió tal como se describe aquí. Gracias a su obstinación por restituir aquello que la Historia quiso borrar, Solzhenitsyn devolvió la palabra a los 227 prisioneros que le brindaron sus testimonios directos y a los millones de personas «a las que les faltó la vida para contar estas cosas», para dejar constancia de uno de los episodios más lúgubres de nuestro tiempo. Escrito entre 1958 y 1967 en la más completa clandestinidad, el primer boceto de la obra fue descubierto por el KGB en septiembre de 1973. En 1974 se publicó en Occidente, como medio de presión desde los países democráticos europeos, y hasta 1990, cuando se publicó parcialmente en la revista «Nóvy Mir», archipiélago Gulag estuvo vedado a los lectores rusos. Este segundo volumen recoge tres de las siete partes que componen la obra completa («Con fines de exterminio», «El alma y el alambre de espinos»), y en él se describen barbaridades como la construcción del Belomor (el canal que comunica el mar Báltico con el mar Blanco) y las argucias a las que debían recurrir los prisioneros para poder sobrevivir. Volumen III. Cuando Alexandr Solzhenitsyn acabó de escribir Archipiélago Gulag, confesaba en el epílogo: «La de veces que empecé este libro para abandonarlo después. No podía acabar de comprender si era necesario o no que escribiera yo solo un libro semejante. Y, además, ¿cuánto tiempo lo soportaría? Pero cuando, sumándose a lo que yo ya había recopilado, convergieron sobre mí otras muchas cartas de presos procedentes de todos los rincones del país, comprendí que, dado que todo esto se me había dado a mí, debía hacerlo». Y es que Solzhenitsyn fue redactando entre 1958 y 1967, en la más absoluta clandestinidad, los numerosos fragmentos que darían lugar a Archipiélago Gulag. Lo hizo sin archivos, partiendo de los recuerdos de sus propias vivencias y de los testimonios de sus compañeros de prisión, y sufriendo en el momento álgido de su trabajo, en 1965, el saqueo de sus papeles junto con el secuestro de la novela El primer círculo. El tercer y último volumen está articulado en dos partes: «El presidio» «Confinamiento» y «Stalin ya no está». En ellas Solzhenitsyn aborda los últimos años del dominio de Stalin y de sus

sucesores, y explica cómo —un cuarto de siglo después de que la Revolución lo aboliera— se restableció el presidio ruso, y con él los «campos especiales» reservados para los presos políticos. Solzhenitsyn describe las condiciones de vida en los campos soviéticos de la posguerra, las evasiones, las huelgas, las revueltas heroicas... El confinamiento en ellos, la otra forma de exilio, afectó a unos quince millones de campesinos y se convirtió en un método generalizado de marginación de los indeseables. «Los dirigentes pasan», decían, «el Archipiélago perdura».
