Continuidad y cambio en la España urbana en el período de entreguerras Jesús Mirás Araujo,2007 El libro analiza la estructura y las transformaciones de la economía de una ciudad española de rango jerárquico medio (A Coruña) durante el período de entreguerras (1914-1935), que se encuadra dentro del creciente interés que ha experimentado en las últimas décadas el estudio histórico de las ciudades españolas. Para evitar caer en un excesivo descriptivismo y localismo, el estudio requiere una adecuada contextualización. El método seguido parte de la caracterización de los cambios que condujeron a la ciudad por la senda de la modernización, pretendiendo insertar su comportamiento en el contexto de las economías española y gallega, y dentro del conjunto del sistema urbano nacional. El resultado final es la percepción de que el primer tercio del siglo XX supuso para la economía y las ciudades españolas un período de desarrollo, en el que la estrategia de A Coruña se centró en su creciente especialización como ciudad terciaria.

La pluralidad de emisión en España, 1844-1874 Carles Sudrià Triay,Yolanda Blasco-Martel,2016-05-31 Este libro aborda el desarrollo financiero de España durante la etapa en que estuvo vigente la pluralidad de bancos de emisión. España inauguró la emisión plural en 1844 y la finalizó formalmente el 19 de marzo de 1874, al firmarse el decreto de concesión del monopolio de emisión al Banco de España. Durante ese período de tiempo, hasta veintiún bancos provinciales desarrollaron tareas de emisión en España. El objetivo de esta obra es analizar el papel jugado por la pluralidad de emisión en el proceso de formación del moderno sistema bancario español. Finalmente, la cuarta y última parte se ocupa de revisar las circunstancias en las que se puso fin a la pluralidad de emisión. El estudio, dirigido a un público amplio, se ha construido sobre la base de fuentes originales, lo que resulta especialmente interesante a los investigadores que se ocupan de la historia bancaria. Sus principales aportaciones se centran, por una parte, en los análisis agregados y desagregados de las cifras de la banca emisora que se presentan y, por otra, en el detallado estudio de los aspectos sociales, institucionales y económicos de la pluralidad de emisión en España.
