Freedom All The Way Up Christian J. Barrigar, 2017-05-19 Freedom All The Way Up proposes four intertwined elements that make up the meaning of life—self-worth, purpose, identity, and hope. Materialism chooses autonomous freedom, but thereby introduces nihilism into each of the elements of meaning. It turns out that nihilism is a much greater problem for Materialism than suffering is for Theism. In contrast, agapic freedom infuses self-worth, purpose, identity, and hope with God's agape-love, dispelling Materialism's inherent nihilism. *Freedom All The Way Up* provides a dramatic new proposal for God and the meaning of life in our scientific and humanist age.
